

Dear High School Parents and Students:

In order to create the best possible educational experience for both families and the Highland Hall high school, we ask that you please read the agreement below carefully and sign at the bottom of the page. The high school expects the following criteria to be agreed to by both parents and students:

1. Academic skills: If a student earns a grade below a C, depending on the course, additional tutoring may be required. This tutoring will either be in school or after school and will be at the expense of the parents.
2. Discipline: Students should conduct themselves in such a way that discipline from a teacher is unnecessary. They should exhibit a positive attitude toward teachers, students, and the subject matter being taught in class. Students need to be at Highland Hall because they have chosen this school, and should behave accordingly.
3. Absenteeism: It is important for students to attend school on a regular basis. Because students experience much of the material through lecture, demonstration, and group work, repeated absenteeism makes it difficult to catch up on material, and it often affects students' grades.
4. Commitment:
 - a. Parents: The parents' commitment is to support their sons or daughters as high school students by ensuring that they complete work at home as needed on a daily basis. Furthermore, parents need to keep an open line of communication with their children and keep in touch with the school on a regular basis.
 - b. Students: The students' commitment is to work to their full potential on their academic studies and to participate in the intellectual and social life of the class and school.

With these criteria, the high school aims to create an environment in which all students can feel successful and have a meaningful high school experience.
