CALL TO ORDER/PRAYER FOR BOARD TRUSTEES

Chair Vernell Goodwin called the meeting to order, and Kenneth Hilliard led the prayer for Board Trustees.

USE OF FACILITIES REQUEST – Gerald Wright

Mr. Wright presented completed paperwork for two (2) Use of Facilities requests and recommended approval.

- **A request for a Class Reunion for Classes 1983 – 2000 on the football field at Holly Hill Elementary Campus - Security will be provided by Orangeburg County Sheriff Department. Mayor William Johnson, Sheriff Leroy Ravenell, and other community members will be participating.**
- **A request for Mike Williams Youth Football Camp and Community Fun Day on the football field/stadium at Lake Marion High School - The camp is for students, ages 6-17, from 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. Student campers will receive free t-shirts and gifts. The Community Fun Day will be held in the afternoon. Security will be provided by the Orangeburg County Sheriff Department.**

Operations and Athletics – Gerald Wright

Summer cleaning is ongoing. Contractual services are scheduled to begin next week. Security camera systems may or may not be completed by the opening of school. Camera system upgrades will be installed at Elloree Elementary and Holly Hill-Roberts Middle. New camera systems will be installed at Vance-Providence, St. James-Gaillard-Elementary, Holly Hill Elementary, and the District Office.
