

130-AR. HOMEWORK GUIDELINES

The amount and type of homework assigned by teachers will vary by class, and even by pupils. A minimal amount of homework will be assigned in the primary elementary grades, with the amount increasing as a student advances through the intermediate, junior high, and senior high grades in accord with the following:

- All students are expected to read and/or be read to daily.
- Different students may take slightly more or less time to complete an assignment.
- Disciplinary action may be taken if work is not completed as directed.
- Parents/guardians may ask in advance (3 days preferred) for homework when they are aware of an upcoming absence.
- Daily homework should not to exceed 15% of a student’s grade.
- Grade level Homework Guidelines are listed below:

Grade	Total Minutes Per Week (Combined From All Courses)
K	Occasional, not to exceed 30 minutes
1	Not to exceed 50 minutes
2	Not to exceed 100 minutes
3	Not to exceed 150 minutes
4	Not to exceed 200 minutes
5	Not to exceed 250 minutes
6	Not to exceed 300 minutes
7	Not to exceed 350 minutes
8	Not to exceed 400 minutes
9-12	No rigid number of hours should be required each week for any particular subject, but rather homework requirements given by the teacher will be flexible and responsive to the preset need and future requirements of the course.

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
