

St. Mary of Wayne School Advisory Committee (SAC)
Minutes for its June 12, 2017 meeting

Present: Bishop Walter Hurley, Mr. Albert Damito, Mrs. Kathy Sparks, Mr. Michael Hurley, Mrs. Jennifer Anderson, Mrs. Sheila Morales, Mrs. Renee Huizar and Mr. John Zech

Mr. Hurley called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and asked Bishop Hurley to lead us in prayer.

Mr. Hurley reported that the minutes of the May 1, 2017 SAC meeting were approved.

Mrs. Sparks then updated the committee on the 2017-2018 enrollment figures. In short, she reported that enrollment for the new school year hasn't changed since her report at the May meeting. She also said a meeting will be held very soon to decide how much money will be distributed through the Blue Knight Legacy Fund and to whom for the school year.

Mrs. Sparks, Mr. Hurley and Bishop Hurley spoke about the new procedures that have been put in place to collect tuition for the 2017-2018 school year.

Mr. Damito, Mr. Hurley and Bishop Hurley reviewed the Parish Budget for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. They also talked about how the parish is doing as the 2016-2017 fiscal year is coming to a close. They mentioned the parish has old CSA debt of @ \$330,000.00. That the parish used to have @ 2,000 families. Now it has @ 950 families. That about one-third of the families do not contribute at all to the parish. In years past, the yearly collection at the masses used to be @ \$750,000.00. Now it is @ \$500,000.00. Never the less the 2017-2018 Budget does include some funding for Capital Projects that have been postponed for some time.

Bishop Hurley spoke about a new role for the School Advisory Committee. He said he wants to do some brainstorming with the committee with regard to growing enrollment. He also talked about some changes that will be made in terms of scheduling the use of parish facilities for meetings. He said the Archdiocese is tightening their policies and procedures regarding CYO and PTG.

Mrs. Sparks said they are looking for a full time school secretary and perhaps a part time person to assist with the many tasks at the school.

Bishop Hurley led us in a closing prayer.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:52pm.
