

Advanced Academic Learners Plan

Llano Junior High School

Students entering the Pre-AP program for the first time in the 2014-2015 school year and beyond will be under the following guidelines when enrolling.

Initial entry into the Pre-AP program shall be dependent upon the student accumulating points based on the following criteria:

CRITERIA	0 POINTS	1 POINT	2 POINTS	3 POINTS
PREVIOUS YEAR TEACHER RECOMMENDATION	Student is unlikely to succeed in Pre-AP coursework	Student is somewhat likely to succeed in Pre-AP coursework	Student is likely to succeed in Pre-AP coursework	Student is well prepared to succeed in Pre-AP coursework
STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES	Student failed to meet standard	Student met level 1 standard	Student met level 2 standard	Student met level 3 standard
GRADES IN SUBJECT AREA	69 and below	70 to 79	80 to 89	90-100

All criteria will be rated by a committee of Pre-AP teachers. Students requesting entry into the Pre-AP program must submit a completed application packet with the above items by the end of the school year preceding their initial request to enter the program. These applications must be returned to the Llano Junior High School Guidance Counselor.

Students will be admitted according to the following system:

- **6 to 9 points - Automatic Admission**
- **3 to 5 points - Committee Will Review to Determine Admittance into Program**
- **2 points or less - Student Will Be Denied Entry into the Program**

Students wanting to be placed in a 7th Grade or 8th Grade Pre-AP Science class will use their score from the previous school year's Math STAAR assessment.

Students transferring in after the start of school that have already enrolled in a Pre-AP program in another district will be placed in Pre-AP and follow local policies.

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EXIT CRITERIA

- Students who fail to maintain an average of 80 in any Pre-AP subject area at the end of the first semester will be removed from that subject area for the second semester and placed in the corresponding course in the regular curriculum.
- Students who fail to maintain an average of 80 in any Pre-AP subject area at the end of the second semester will be denied entry into Pre-AP curriculum in that subject area the following year. Students may choose to go through the application process a second time to regain entry into the program by completing the requirements for initial entry into the program again. Students choosing this option will not be subject to automatic entry into the program. All students attempting to regain entry will be subject to committee review to determine acceptance.
- Any student whose behavior in the classroom interferes with the ability of students to learn or the teacher to teach may be removed entirely from the program.
