## Purchase of a **Learning Management System (LMS)**

### Project Scope

Tipton County Schools is seeking a learning management system solution to consolidate adopted and supplemental publisher content into a single platform and extend online and blended learning opportunities of students and staff members. Currently, Tipton County Schools does not have an LMS. Tipton County Schools anticipates full integration and implementation will be completed by fall of 2018.

Tipton County Schools is looking to fulfill the following objectives through the selected learning management system:

- Provide an adaptable, engaging, up-to-date, and meaningful online learning environment for all face-to-face students in grades 6-12 within one learning management system, and potentially a system that would meet the needs of grades K-5.
- Deliver purchased publisher content, provide access to Open Educational Resources (OER), and provide teachers with the tools to curate and tag and share learning resources.
- Provide an online environment that supports various professional development needs including fully online courses and supplemental content.
- Consolidate past purchased publisher content, as may be provided by publishers
- Integrate with Skyward student management system

### Number of System Users

The Tipton County Schools implementation of a Learning Management System will include 11,250 students and 826 teachers and administrators.
