

SHAC Minutes  
November 15, 2010 Meeting

SHAC President Diane Gwinn called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m. Cheryl Hall read the notes from the October 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. Mrs. Chumbly made a motion to accept the minutes as read and Mrs. Gwinn seconded it. There was no public input and all were in favor.

Life Steps was discussed in Mrs. Youngman's class. Youngman had already started during red ribbon week. Class has to be 10 weeks in a row. Recommendation made to present to School Board that as reinforcement to red ribbon week, Life Steps present an evidence based prevention curriculum for 10 weeks during Character Building time for Thrall 3, 4 and 5 grade students. The program Too good For Drugs has been approved by DSHS and is used in several neighboring school districts. Trained Life Steps staff would present the curriculum (their time and expertise is free), for only the cost of a Life Skills workbook (99 cents per student). Motion was made by Mrs. Beckerman and seconded by Mrs. Chumbly. All were in favor. 2011 school year interagency will look for funding options.

P.A.P.A. update - Coach Doege has attended classes and will teach P.A.P.A.

Puberty film update - Mrs. Gwinn recommended the Always Changing and Always Growing video be shown to the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. As a reminder, Mr. Ball and Nurse Crabb are targeting these discussions for December 2010 during P.E. Mrs. Van Til made a motion and it was seconded by Mrs. Woelfel. All were in favor.

It was noted that we applied for a salad bar grant. We will know after January 15, 2011 if we received the grant from Whole Foods.

Motion was made by Mrs. Gwinn that assignments be given for review and recommendations for changes to the Wellness Policy and was seconded by Mrs. Van Til. All were in favor.
