GENERAL MEETING

BUSINESS

1. Review and approve 4/19/2017 minutes
 - a. Gina Loyonett made a motion to approve the minutes.
 - i. Correction as noted on Dawn Tull being on SSC for 4 years
 - b. Dawn Tull second the motion.

2. SSC members update
 - a. Nomination forms were sent out on May 23rd through the Tuesday runners. No nominations were returned.
 - b. Nomination forms will be sent out at the beginning of next school year.

3. SPSA Annual Evaluation
 - a. Reviewed goals and progress in SSC meeting on 4/19/2017
 - b. Teachers are currently giving math, reading, and writing assessments
 - c. Data will be collected to align with LCAP goals
 - d. This school year we added a school climate goal in SPSA. School climate will continue to be addressed 2017-2018 school year.
 - e. Community projects to be expanded throughout all grade levels and provide support to teachers and students.
 - f. MHS to continue to provide interventions next school year
 - g. Media lab assistant was hired. He is interested in providing math intervention during the school day.
 - h. Next school year the media lab assistant hours are 19.75 hours. Due to the decrease of hours, not all classes will have a media lab assistant to assist the teacher. Ms. Marquez asked if a college intern can assist to support classes in the media lab. Ms. Salas asked how is the district going to continue to support students with computer skills. Next school year, teachers will be asked if they

need a media lab assistant during their media lab time. All SPUSD elementary schools will adjust their 30 hours to 19.75 hours for the media lab assistant.

- i. PTA purchased 12 additional chromebooks
- j. Ms. Jean Yu asked what do upper grade students work on during the media lab time. Upper grade classes work on research, presentation tools, and word documents. iMovie has not been worked on for about 2 years.
- k. We will continue to align with LCAP using assessment data.
