"NO NIT" GUIDELINE

Tooele County School District "No Nit" (head lice eggs) Guideline: If a student is suspected of having head lice, school personnel may check them. If head lice are found, the parent/guardian may be notified to pick up the student. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to treat the student with a head lice product and most importantly to **remove all nits and head lice from the student's hair**. The student cannot be readmitted to the school if there are any nits or head lice present. School personnel should check the student before they return to their classroom. If a class is having an unusual high number of students with head lice, parents/guardians may be notified and school personnel may screen the class. **Parents are encouraged to check their student's hair for nits and head lice throughout the school year.**
