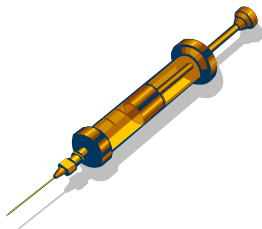

Freehold Township residents will be charged \$20.00 for physicals.

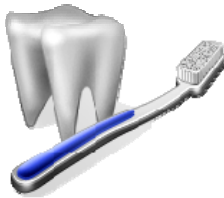

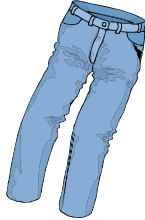
