NOTICE TO BIDDERS

1. Notice is hereby given that the governing board (“Board”) of the New Haven Unified School District (“District” or “Owner”) will receive sealed bids for the following project (“Project” or “Contract”):

CESAR CHAVEZ MS & ITLIONG –VERA CRUZ MS TRACK IMPROVEMENTS

2. Sealed Bids will be received until 2:30 p.m., June 6th, 2017, at the District Office, 34200 Alvarado Niles Road, Union City, California, at or after which time the bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. Any claim by a bidder of error in its bid must be made in compliance with section 5100 et seq. of the Public Contract Code.
3. The Project consists of:

Rip and renovate existing track surface and its event areas. Weed removal of entire track and its event areas. Install new decomposed granite to track surface and incorporate into existing material, providing sufficient infill to bring surface up to a leveled finish. Re-grade to suit drainage toward catch basins in turf area and roll for compaction.
4. All bids shall be on the form provided by the District. Each bid must conform and be responsive to all pertinent Contract Documents, including, but not limited to, the Instructions to Bidders.
5. To bid on this Project, the Bidder is required to possess one or more of the following State of California Contractor Licenses: A, B, or C-27

The Bidder's license(s) must remain active and in good standing throughout the term of the Contract.

6. A bid bond by an admitted surety insurer on the form provided by the District, cash, or a cashier's check or a certified check, drawn to the order of the New Haven Unified School District, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid price, shall accompany the Bid Form and Proposal, as a guarantee that the Bidder will, within seven (7) calendar days after the date of the Notice of Award, enter into a contract with the District for the performance of the services as stipulated in the bid.
7. The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a 100 % Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond if it is awarded the contract for the Work.

8. The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.
9. The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all work performed pursuant to this Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Prevailing wage rates are also available from the District or on the Internet at: <http://www.dir.ca.gov>.
10. A **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference and site visit will be held on May 22, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. at 2801 Hop Ranch Road, Union City, California. All participants are required to sign in front of the Administration Building. *Failure to attend or tardiness of more than 15 minutes will render bid ineligible.*
11. Contract Documents are available for review at the Facilities Department at 3636 Smith Street, Union City California.

Plans and specifications may be purchased directly from New Haven Unified School District.
12. The District's Board has found and determined that the following item(s) shall be used on this Project based on the purpose(s) indicated. (Public Contract Code section 3400(b)): A particular material, product, thing, or service is designated by specific brand or trade name for the following purpose(s): N/A
13. The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any irregularity in any bid received. If the District awards the Contract, the security of unsuccessful bidder(s) shall be returned within sixty (60) days from the time the award is made. Unless otherwise required by law, no bidder may withdraw its bid for ninety (90) days after the date of the bid opening.
14. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].
15. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.
16. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations

17. The District shall award the Contract, if it awards it at all, to the lowest responsive responsible bidder based on: **The base bid amount only.**

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
