

Vallivue School District #139

The board of trustees of Vallivue School District adopts this policy to encourage and facilitate parental participation in Title I educational programs and experiences of students. This policy provides the framework for organized, systematic, ongoing, informed, and timely parent involvement relative to decisions about the Title I services within the district.

Consistent with Section 1118, this school district will work with its schools to ensure that the required school-level parental involvement policies meet the requirements of Section 1118(b) of the Elementary Secondary Education Act, and each include, as a component, a School-Parent Compact consistent with Section 1118(d) of the ESEA. The district is committed to providing the support necessary to assist Title I schools in planning and implementing effective parental involvement activities to improve student academic achievement and school performance.

In carrying out the Title I, Part A parental involvement requirements, to the extent practicable, the school district and its schools will provide full opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children and will provide information and school reports required under Section 1118 of the ESEA in an understandable and uniform format, including alternative formats upon request and, to the extent practicable, in a language parents understand.

To facilitate meaningful parent involvement, each school will:

1. Form a Parent Advisory Committee.
2. Develop a written parental involvement (plan) policy jointly with parent input.
3. Hold a Title Annual Meeting at the beginning of the year to explain to parents the program, its requirements, and their right to be involved.
4. Annually review and distribute the Parent Involvement Plan.
5. Annually review the Parent /School Compact.
6. Annually establish how Title I Parent Involvement Funds will be used.
7. Annually review the use of Title I funds and evaluate the use of these funds.
8. Build capacity for strong parental involvement.
9. Involve parents in the process of school review and improvement.
10. Identify barriers to greater participation by parents in school activities and work to remove those barriers.
