THE DONNIE HOLLOWELL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Purpose

The fund is a memorial to Donnie Hollowell (1993-2014), who attended Ascension Episcopal School for his elementary school education. The fund was established in 2014 as a tribute to Donnie's youth after he died of Osteosarcoma, a cancer that starts in the bones. The scholarship provides tuition assistance to elementary students promoting to grades 3-5.

Procedure

This award is given annually to an Ascension Episcopal School elementary student promoting to grades 3-5. Applications should be submitted to the Head of School.

Requirements

1. The applicant must be in AES elementary promoting to grades 3-5.
2. The applicant attended AES for two school years.
3. The application is completed between April 4-19 of the school year prior to need.
4. Candidates have an A/B average and good conduct grades in each class.
5. Candidates participate in all areas of AES service and leadership as available for their grade level.
6. Students who receive financial aid are not eligible for this award.

The monetary award will be applied to the student's tuition for the year. This award is not a set amount but will vary each year (\$1000+) based upon the funding available.

Decision

A committee consisting of the Head of School and AES Faculty will review the requests and the award will be presented in May at the Awards Ceremony.
