

Important Immunization Information for Northville Public School Families

For students entering preschool programs, kindergarten, 7th grade and any students that are new to the district.

All immunizations must be **up to date and on file in the school office** prior to their first day of school in accordance with the Michigan state law enacted in 2014.

Your child must have an updated immunization record OR an immunization waiver from the county Health Department BEFORE they can start school. Your child will not be able to start school if one of these documents is not on file in the school office. The schools are no longer permitted to distribute waiver forms and can only accept those from the county Health Department.

Contact your child's medical provider immediately to arrange for any needed immunizations or your local Health Department to arrange an appointment for the educational session required to obtain the waiver.

If you live in Oakland County call 1-800-848-5533
Call early to make certain you can get an appointment before school starts.
