KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY NEEDS OF EACH STUDENT* MUST HAVE:

FULL SIZE Backpack (needs to fit communication folder and art work)

Crayola or Prang Oil Pastels Set

Crayola or Prang Chalk Pastels set

Crayola or Prang watercolor set with brush (not the washable set, it does not work as well)

One box of tissues

2 Bottles of White Elmer's School Glue (4 oz size)

Pack of glue sticks

Three large containers of disinfectant wipes

1 Set of thin black whiteboard markers (EXPO preferred)

1 White t-shirt (the white t-shirts run small so please buy your child a larger size shirt)

Crayola 10 pack classic color markers (or any other color markers would be appreciated)

Crayola 12 pack color pencils (please no erasable or twistable)

***When your child's teacher visits you, he/she can give you more details and examples of what is needed.**
