

## Math Problem of the Week Scoring Rubric

Score	Criteria
4	The method used by the student is mathematically correct and easily understood. All steps are shown and explained correctly. The answer is correct. The problem statement contains all information needed to solve the problem including any charts, tables, diagrams, etc. Words are spelled correctly and correct mathematical terms are used. All labels are included where needed. The cover includes necessary student information, has a title and illustrates the topic of the POW.
3	The method used could lead to a correct solution, but contains some errors. Mathematical steps are missing, not completely explained or contain computation errors. Incorrect math vocabulary is used. The problem statement does not contain all information (including charts or diagrams) needed to solve the problem.
2	The method used is not clear and may contain flaws in reasoning. Mathematical steps are missing or contain errors but show some understanding of the solution.
1	The method used is unclear or would not lead to a correct solution. Steps are missing or contain many errors. The response indicates limited understanding and there may be incorrect application of skills or procedures.
