Thomas E. "Tom" Pitzer Aviation Maintenance Scholarship

This scholarship provides \$1,000 to help a worthy candidate pursue an Associate of Applied Science Degree with FAA A&P Certification or an alternate degree filed related to aviation maintenance. The scholarship is offered to an Oregon public high school senior or high school graduate with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen and plan to attend an accredited and FAA approved school within Oregon, such as Lane or Portland Community College, and start in the Fall term. You may also apply if you have previously received the scholarship in past years.

The scholarship funds are to be used for tuition and books only. Upon receipt of the degree, the recipient of the scholarship must commit to working three years within the aviation maintenance industry.

- A one-page resume
- A one-page essay describing your interest in obtaining a private pilot's license or an aviation maintenance degree
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher or career guidance counselor
