



Playground Rules

The Playground is provided for students recess enjoyment. To reduce the possibility of injury, students are expected to be considerate of others and to obey the instructions of the teachers. Students and teachers are to observe the following when using the playground:

- 1. Throwing rocks, sand, sawdust, or any object other than balls, Frisbees, etc., is not allowed.**
- 2. Baseballs or hard softballs are not allowed for playground use.**
- 3. Faxon Academy is not responsible for personal items that may be lost or broken. Toys and other personal belongings from home will not be allowed on the playground.**
- 4. Climbing on or over fences to retrieve balls is not allowed. Students should seek assistance from their teacher.**
- 5. Fighting, quarrels, or other difficulties should be reported to the Principal immediately.**
- 6. Doors leading to the playground should never be propped open.**
- 7. Teachers are not allowed to bring chairs onto the playground area, unless authorized by the Principal.**
- 8. Teachers will always participate with the students during playground activities.**
- 9. Students are not allowed to perform acrobatic stunts, i.e. back flips, cartwheels; etc., regardless of how proficient or coordinated the student may be. Any injuries that occur on the playground must be reported to the Principal. In the event that the student or staff member requires further medical attention that requires hospitalization, the Principal will inform the district Superintendent.**
