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INTERNAL OPERATIONS

SUBJECT: COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

The Board and/or the President of the Board may at its discretion establish committees for the purpose of undertaking a specific task in connection with Board activity. These committees, however, cannot make legal decisions for the entire Board.

At the request of the Board, the President shall appoint temporary committees consisting of fewer than the full membership for special purposes. These committees shall be discharged on the completion of their assignment. The President of the Board shall be an ex-officio member of such committees.

The Board of Education recognizes that it may be necessary from time to time to authorize advisory committees for the purpose of enlisting opinions and counsel of the general public. Such committees shall be appointed by the Board of Education.

Standing Committees - Advisory

The following shall be standing advisory committees, membership to be appointed by the Board President as soon as possible after the Reorganizational Meeting. At least two (2), but no more than three (3) Board members will be assigned to each standing committee. Each Board member will accept at least one standing advisory committee assignment. The Board President or the Board as a whole may establish standing committees and reserves the right to terminate any committees at any time.

Audit/Finance Committee
Facilities Committee
Policy Committee
Personnel Committee

The chief function of an advisory committee is to undertake such studies as may be advisable and to make recommendations so the Board as a whole may take appropriate action.

Any member of the Board may submit matters to these committees for study and reaction. Such submission shall be made by making a motion to "refer to committee" at a regular Board meeting. The Superintendent may submit any pertinent data to the committee. The committee, within a 30-day period, shall submit to the Board (orally or in writing) the status on matters before it.

Visitation Committees

The Board of Education shall appoint one or more committees, to visit every school building at least once annually.

Ad Hoc Committees

Ad hoc committees may be established by the Board President or the Board as a whole for the purpose of topic research and the enlisting of opinions and counsel from school district stakeholders. Such committees shall follow the same protocols as outlined above.
