Thank you to all parents, teachers & staff for supporting these very important bond measures. Yesterday, Manhattan Beach voters overwhelmingly approved Both C (70%) and EE (67%)!

What Now?

Now and for the next few months, the District takes its next steps to utilize C and EE to repair and improve our schools.

Working with a bond underwriter, the District will take initial steps to issue the first series of bonds to cover the design expenses for the bonds and renovation plans. Interviewing and eventually hiring architectural firms is an important first step. Those architects will utilize projects detailed in the [Facilities Master Plan](#) and begin to work with the community to determine each school site's greatest needs based on available funds.
