



Charlotte Choice Charter
Technology Agreement

I, _____, (student's name) and my parent/guardian, _____, agree to all of the following provisions regarding student use of technology resources on Charlotte Choice Charter (CCC) premises or at a school-sponsored event.

1. Student use of technology and the Internet on CCC premises or at a school sponsored-event is a privilege that may be taken away at any time.
2. All personal technology resources (this includes but is not limited to cellular phones, tablets, computers, etc.) shall be turned off unless their use is authorized by a CCC employee.
 - a. If the personal technology resource permitted for use is a computer, the student must have a power supply for their own technology.
 - b. All personal technology equipment/supplies must be clearly labeled with the student's name. This includes, but is not limited to, the technology, power cord, and carrying cases.
 - c. Personal technology resources shall only be available for use as authorized by a CCC employee; any unauthorized use may subject the student to discipline, including and up to expulsion.
 - d. While on CCC premises or at a school-sponsored event, students shall use their personal technology resources, in a safe, responsible, and appropriate manner. Cyber bullying will not be tolerated.
 - e. CCC is not responsible for any damage to personal technology resources.
3. Students are responsible for all work assigned, even if the technology resource they use is being repaired. CCC shall provide resources necessary to complete assignments.
4. Students shall use CCC technology and the Internet in a safe, responsible, and appropriate manner.
5. Students shall have no expectation of privacy in CCC or personal technology resources while on CCC premises or at a school-sponsored event. Computer files and electronic communications, including email, are not private and may be accessed by CCC at any time for the limited purpose of ensuring compliance with CCC policies and regulations. This includes computer files and electronic communications which are accessed using CCC technology or through the CCC's network but are stored externally.
6. Students shall not install software onto CCC laptop or desktop computers without consent or direction from CCC employee.
7. Students shall not interfere with, delete, or disable any CCC-installed program(s) or application(s) on CCC laptop or desktop computers.
8. Students shall not damage CCC technology and shall be financially responsible for any repair or replacement required, as determined by the principal or her designee.
