## Dance Update

- Waiting on cafeteria receipt to see what they'll charge us for the water. About \$800 profit.
- About \$60 in found money that has been unclaimed. We'll deposit it so it isn't laying around. Wait to see if someone calls. Hoping a kid didn't take it out of their piggy bank.

## Book Fair Update

- Used \$3,289.87 of Scholastic Dollars for teacher class books. Library used \$800 in Scholastic Dollars. Total sale: \$6,791.44. Best fall fair. Waiting to hear the official word from Scholastic.
- Our extra change we set aside has increased since we started this fair. Kids aren't having to put a book back because they are short a few cents. Now and then a parent donates extra money to the extra money fund.
- The books offered in the classroom flyers and the book fair offer different books. Can we schedule the book fair to be a separate week and the classroom flyers being sent home? Both sets of flyers went home in the same week and kids were confused.
- Can we give the counselors a gift certificate for the book fair? They are using their own money and we gave the teachers \$50 this year.
- The spring book fair pulls in more money. Partly because it is in conjunction with PARP Fest. If we were to cut out a book fair it would be the fall one, but do we want to? There is a 10% kickback from Scholastic we receive for having a second fair each school year.
- We can't spend the Scholastic Dollars as quickly as we are earning them. We earned \$3100 in Scholastic Dollars. We'd get half that if we opted for cash.
- Jen Bertrand and Jade Western came up with \$750.75 to spend in Scholastic Dollars for STEM items. There is a cash counter in the catalog we may want to add for our own use. It'll cost \$350 Scholastic Dollars and we'll check to see if there is a coin counter. There is a shipping cost, but there is a cap, so we'll put the whole order in at once.

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## Spirit Gear Fundraiser

- 10% profit on paid items. \$7,055 in sales. \$78 in free shirts. \$627.50 profit. Next year we'll choose different styles to offer.

## Open House

- Kick back from Kona Ice. \$82 was deposited.

## Teacher Requests

- We give WSS Counseling \$500 every year and they asked for cash. Aimee will get that for them.
- We need to review allotments for each grade so we can plan and adjust appropriately.
- **4TH GRADE:** Requested \$450 to see the movie Wonder because they read the book in class. Opens Nov. 17 and they'd all go on Nov. 28 which is a discounted ticket price day. They have 30 free tickets. In years passed they haven't used their full allotment.  
APPROVED
- **1ST GRADE:** Want to go to GCV&M in May for the Life of Reptiles. Requesting \$630 and their allotment is \$600. Not sure if this is a new field trip. Do they plan on any other trips this year? Tabled for more info.
- Kari will meet with Jen Bertrand to make our teacher request forms electronic so we have them right away and can ask any questions immediately.

## Cookie Dough Fall Fundraiser

- Need to find an Otis Spunkmeyer Distributor. Last time was Cherrydale. The profit varies depending on how many pieces are sold. Can be up to 50% profit. Have to sell 200 pieces to receive free shipping.
- Believe Kids who did our Spirit Gear distributes Otis Spunkmeyer. Nikki will get more info from them.
