COMMUNITY SERVICE ESSENTIALS

Community Service Graduation Requirement

The PYLUSD Community Service graduation requirement supports the belief that students benefit from the opportunity to make meaningful connections and enrich the lives of others by performing service for their community without receiving any external reward or financial benefit. This requirement is intended to assist students in becoming educated citizens within a safe and successful community. This requirement involves students working on a VOLUNTARY basis in non-profit agencies, the public sector or educational institutions.

40 hours completed community service is required by May 1st of your senior year (60 hours for ECHS, Parkview, La Entrada). Students are encouraged to start early!

- Graduation requirement is 40 service hours by May 1st of Senior year. (60 hours for ECHS, Parkview, La Entrada)
- Plan ahead. Volunteer opportunities will be announced in student bulletins, posted on campus, and on school and district websites.
- Privately arranged hours (e.g. babysitting, gardening) DO NOT count.
- Volunteering time at a FOR-PROFIT business DOES NOT count.
- Volunteering at a company owned by a relative or friend DOES NOT count unless it is a non-profit organization.
- Job Shadowing DOES NOT count for CS hours.
- Service must be done outside of the students academic day.
- Religious activities must be activities that extend beyond the church. No proselytizing.
- If you have questions, check with your CS Coordinator about activities BEFORE you start!
- All CS forms are available on campus and online. Please return verification forms to the CS coordinator on your campus. Keep a copy for your records!
- Falsified hours will result in suspension. All hours are subject to verification.
- Please allow 2-3 weeks to process paperwork.
