St. Joseph's Society To Award 16 \$1,000 Scholarships

St. Joseph's Society, with the help of Hope for the Future, will award two \$1,000 scholarships to incoming freshmen at each of the eight San Antonio Catholic high schools. These scholarships will be awarded based on grades, class attendance, extracurricular activities, community service, Church service, family income, and other criteria. These scholarships will be renewable for \$500 provided certain criteria are met. Application packets will be available Feb 11 through April 5 at St. Joseph's Society Hall at 420 E Cesar Chavez. Completed applications must be received by April 15. The office is open Monday through Friday from 3:30 pm to 7:00 pm. Online registration is now open at <http://eepurl.com/bOc3mn>. Educators and parents are asked register online to receive information on the scholarship as it becomes available. **Students must register online by March 31** in order to be considered for these scholarships. This year's scholarship recipients will be selected on April 25 and an awards banquet will be held on May 29.

The Catholic high schools in San Antonio that are included in this program are Antonian College Preparatory High School, Central Catholic High School, Holy Cross of San Antonio, Incarnate Word High School, Providence Catholic School, St. Anthony Catholic High School, St. Gerard Catholic High School, and The Atonement Academy.

The main fundraising comes from participation in the King William Fair and from rental of their banquet hall. The Society hopes to raise additional funds to expand the scholarship program.
