

Dear Parents,

This letter is to update you on progress with the MoMEntum literacy pilot. MoMEntum has partnered with NWEA and eSpark to personalize your student's literacy development. eSpark is dedicated to providing educational curriculum customized for each student based upon his or her learning level and goals as determined by classroom teachers and NWEA reading results. Because eSpark creates a personalized curriculum, it is necessary for us to share the following information about each student:

- Student Roster. This file contains information about your students and which teacher's classroom they are in. The data fields are: school name, section name, student id, student first name, student last name, grade level, teacher first name, teacher last name, teacher email, nwea id.
- NWEA Assessment Results. This is a file that includes student id, percentile rank and RIT scores for each student on each domain among other fields and is processed securely by the eSpark system.
- NWEA Students By School. This is a file that includes student id, name, school and grade among other fields and is processed securely by the eSpark system.

In addition to classroom instruction, the benefit of this partnership is that each child will have learning apps that are specifically tailored to their individual needs and interests. As the project begins to take shape, we will keep you informed about your child's progress.
