II. LCAP Draft Goal Review, Common Themes

Review of DELAC LCAP survey results (4/19 DELAC meeting) and input activity results (3/1 DELAC meeting). DELAC members engaged in prioritization of supplemental services students receive as well as commenting on array of services provided to English Learners. Community, parents and DELAC members identified the following as areas for prioritization: technology in the classroom, parent classes, positive school to home communication, and extra support in the form of intersession, summer school, and/or tutorial support for English Learners.

DELAC President Laura Crespo, reviewed and approved application for Funding for the 2017-18 LCAP and Title IIIA & B Plans.
