<p>KidCheck Health Fair This may be the only medical exam a student has every year. Please encourage participation. Please remember the UA faculty and student nurses are volunteering their time to help our students.</p>	<p>Students with Diabetes Diabetic students must NEVER be sent to the nurse alone if they feel sick, weak, or "low". It is crucial that these students always have their snacks and meals on time. (Remember this, especially on field trips or special events.)</p>	<p>Students with Severe Allergies Please notify your school nurse immediately if you have a student with an Epi-pen or other emergency medication.</p>
<p>Wellness Screenings Fall Wellness Screenings are scheduled. Your nurse has the date for your school.</p>	<p>Employee Flu Shots Flu shots will be available on Wellness Screening days.</p>	<p>Flu Vaccinations for Students Please encourage your students to get vaccinated. The date for your school will be scheduled soon.</p>
