

# Partnership at Las Vegas (PAL)

## Code of Conduct

### General Conduct Expectations:

Students in the LVHS PAL Program must abide by the following expectations regarding conduct on and off campus:

1. No longer am I simply myself. I reflect those I serve and am associated with at LVHS, at home and in the community.
2. I do NOT cheat, lie, or steal; including the classroom, the internship, the community, and field trips. I am trustworthy and accountable.
3. I set a positive example for others to follow.
4. I am tolerant of those who may not share the same level of commitment I have (to academics, family, friends, activities etc.), and those who have even more commitment than I.
5. I hold great expectations and will focus only on my accomplishments and not my disappointments.
6. I realize that I represent LVHS PAL both in and outside of school including the jobsite. I will hold myself to a high standard.
7. I will strive to be the positive voice for my program and school.
8. I will always strive to be worthy of the responsibilities I have been given. This includes promoting the goals, objectives, and membership of PAL to the best of my ability.
9. I will conduct myself with the maturity expected of my internship and the PAL program.

### Behavior Conduct Expectations:

1. I will not knowingly violate laws regarding drinking of alcohol or drug use.
2. I will not knowingly be involved in gang membership, or take part in other illegal activities, and I understand that I may be immediately removed from PAL and /or LVHS if I reject this non-negotiable rule.
3. I will not take part in acts of hazing or harassment.

### Technology Conduct Expectations:

Students in the LVHS PAL Program must abide by the following rules in regards to computer and phone use. This includes Tumblr, Instagram, Snapchat, Facebook, Twitter, Interact, text messages, phone calls, and/or any similar website or social network that may be online.

**The following are NOT permitted:**

1. Sending, receiving, or displaying offensive messages or pictures is prohibited.
2. Using obscene language (including FML and other obscene abbreviations) in messages or status updates or any other published language is prohibited.

3. Harassing, insulting, or attacking others on any website or chat forum is prohibited.
4. Use of chat lines, chat rooms, any open chat pages, etc. must always be considered school appropriate regardless where that use takes place.
5. No references or discussions of a sexual nature or illegal activities.
6. If someone asks or posts questions that are obscene in anyway, the student may not respond in an obscene way. The comment must be removed from the page.
7. Other PAL students names may not be posted or commented on in a negative way. Even if a student's name is not used, but the student is being implied, the post is prohibited.
8. Even if someone doesn't "follow" you or is not "friends" with you, you still must follow the above guidelines.
