The CHS Coyote Boosters fund has been established to offer four \$1000 scholarships to graduating seniors who will attend a post high school program or college.

**I. General Qualifications**

- A. Applicant is a high school senior currently enrolled at Columbia High School.
- B. Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited educational or training institution.
  - 1. The candidate may be enrolled in any field of study.
  - 2. A candidate may use the scholarship at any accredited college, university or training institution.
  - 3. A candidate must provide proof of enrollment at any accredited college, university or training institution. A one-time payment will be made to the registrar of the chosen school in one complete installment at the beginning of the school year.
- C. Application must be received in the Columbia High School office by Friday, April 27, 2018 by 3:00 p.m. to Ms. Custer.
- D. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.

**II. Application Requirements**

- A. Applicants for scholarships must complete an application form. All forms must be submitted in a 12 pt. font. Additional paper may be attached.
- B. Grade Point Average (curriculum will be considered as well as grades). A copy of applicant's transcripts must be provided.
- C. Two letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application. One letter of recommendation must be from a community source.
- D. Any application received after 3:00 p.m. on April 27, 2018 and missing any of the above requirements will not be considered.**

**III. Selection Criteria**

- A. School and community involvement
- B. Grade Point Average (curriculum will be considered as well as grades). A copy of applicant's transcript must be included.
- C. Letters of Recommendation.
- D. Selection will be announced at CHS Academic Awards Night.

## **Columbia High School Coyote Boosters Scholarship Committee Guidelines**

The scholarship program will be reviewed and approved annually by the membership vote at the budget planning meeting and the amount available for scholarships will be determined by a meeting vote annually.

### **Committee**

The committee shall consist of 2 members of the Columbia Coyote Boosters and at least two outside community members. A parent member of a senior student may not serve on the committee. It is the committee's sole responsibility to select the scholarship recipients.

### **Eligibility**

To be eligible to apply for a scholarship, the student must be a senior at Columbia High School and have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA for regular curriculum. The student must have firm plans to continue their education at a four or two year school, or technical program. The student must also submit their transcript and two letters of recommendation, one of them being from a community source. Applications must be typed in a size 12 font.

### **Selection Criteria**

The applications will be numbered with the name page separated from the application. The list of names and assigned numbers should not for any reason be given to the scholarship committee. All student names, addresses, and other forms of identification should be blacked out with a marker. The applications and eligibility guidelines will be available on the Columbia School District website. An announcement about the scholarship opportunity should be put in the Columbia School District monthly newsletter sometime after the first of the year.

### **Recommended Selection Process**

Each member of the scholarship committee reviews the applications. Committee members then rate the application on a scale of 1-5 on grammar, content, involvement and letters of recommendation. The committee then convenes and tallies the scholarships. Those applications with a majority of points receive first consideration.
