

School Policies



Closed Campus

North High School is a “closed” campus. Once a student arrives on campus during the school day, the student cannot leave without permission of the parent or guardian. A student is considered to be on campus for the school day when entering school property from China Grade Loop on the south, Stockton St. on the east, Universe Ave. on the north, and McCray St. on the west.

Skateboards:

For reasons related to the safety and security of the North High campus, skateboards must be locked up in the skateboard racks located on the west side of the choir building. Students are responsible for providing their own lock. Students bringing skateboards on campus during the school day and to school sponsored events will have their board confiscated.

Electronic Devices and Music Speakers:

Students are permitted to access their electronic devices during passing periods and at lunch. All electronic devices should be on silent or turned off during instructional time.

Students are not permitted to play music aloud from their electronic device and/or a speaker while on campus. Devices that are playing music aloud will be confiscated.

Securing an Off-Campus permit during the lunch hour window:

It is recommended to students and to their parents that all personal appointments (doctor, dentist, driver’s training, etc.) be made after school hours. However, on those occasions when this is impossible, students and parents need to be aware of the “lunch window” in regards to securing an Off Campus Pass*. **The lunch window timeframe exists between 12:30 – 1:15 on a regular schedule day. During this period a student cannot obtain an Off Campus Pass unless his/her parent or guardian physically comes to campus to sign the student out of school.**

**Students can never leave campus without first securing an “Off Campus Pass” that has been authorized by the student’s parent or guardian. It is important, therefore, to always have guardianship information updated on the student’s Emergency Card.*
