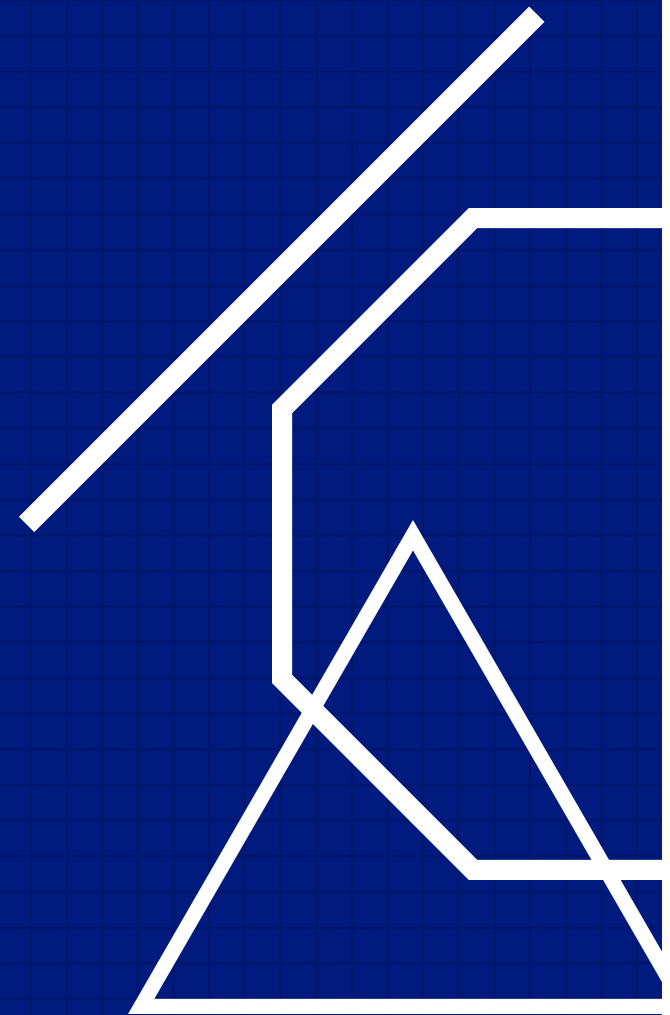

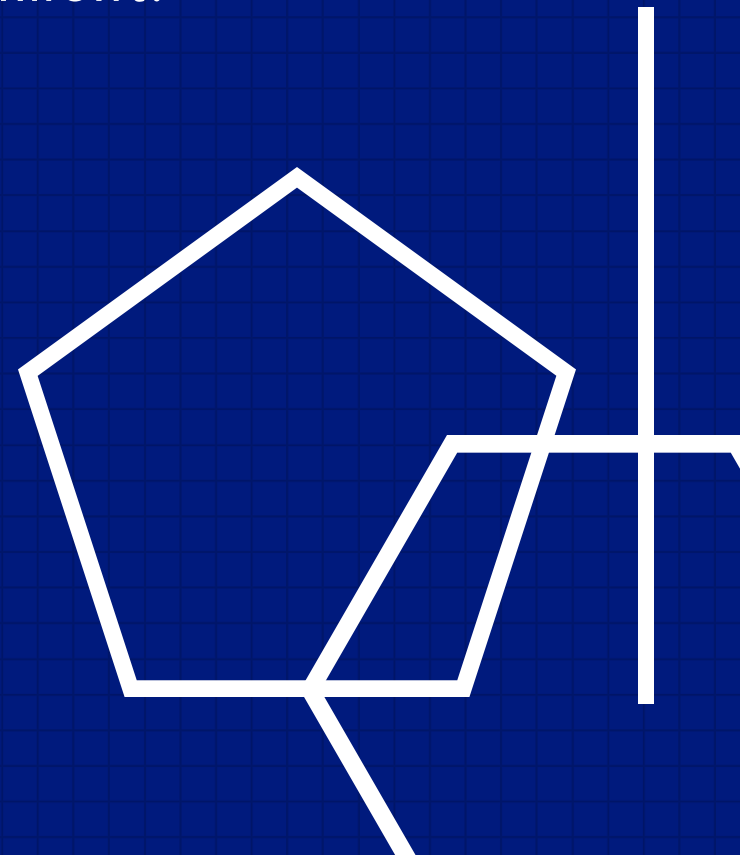
WHAT WE HAVE WORKED ON SO FAR...
