Battle of the Books – 12 students read books and competed in the county competition taking home 3 medals.

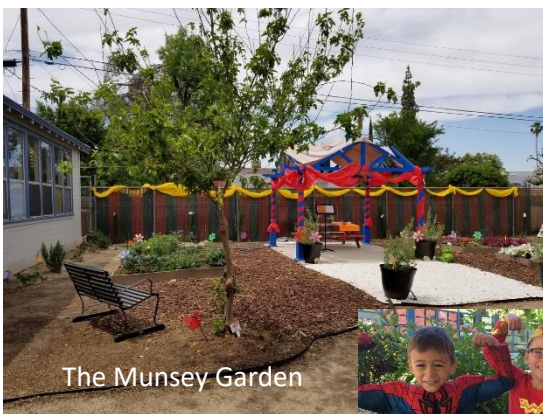
Academic Pentathlon – 10 Students have been working hard to be ready to compete in May.
