







Spring 2017 Session 1 Schedule

Session 1 Class Descriptions & Schedule

LEGO Club: Cost: \$25, Mondays 2:30-3:30PM for 4 weeks, in room 1. Grades 1-6. Club size up to 10 students. Runs February 6 – March 6. No club will be held February 20 in observance of Presidents Day Join Mr. Velasquez for creativity, design, and engineering in the all-new LEGO Club! Students will design and build LEGO creations and learn new skills.

Soccer Club: Cost: \$25, Mondays 2:30-3:45PM for 4 weeks, on Mountain field. Grades 1-3, co-ed. Club size minimum 8, maximum 14 students. Runs February 6 – March 6. No club will be held February 20 in observance of Presidents Day Join Mr. Jimenez for drills to enhance soccer ability while playing fun soccer games before scrimmaging, at the end of practice.

Clay Art: Cost: \$25, Tuesdays 2:30-3:30PM for 5 weeks in Art Room. Grades 2-6. Club size up to 8 students. Runs February 7 – March 7. Join Ms. Snyder for pottery and sculpting with clay. Students will develop creativity, explore new sculpting techniques, and have a clay project to take home.

Typing Skills: Cost: \$25, Tuesdays 2:30-3:30PM in the Computer Lab. Grades 3-6. Club size up to 15 students. Runs February 7 – March 7. Join Ms. Grindle to learn this important life skill that will benefit students in school and beyond. Students will have access to a licensed typing program for practice at home.

Garden Club: Cost: \$25, Wednesdays 1:30-3:00PM in the Garden. Grades K-6. Club size up to 15 students. Runs February 8 – March 8. Join Ms. Wayte in the garden to get dirty and learn about science and agriculture. Students will learn about plants, enjoy garden arts and crafts, eat food from the garden, and play games.

Cooking Club: Cost: \$25, Wednesdays 1:30-3:00PM in the Teacher Lounge kitchen. Grades 3-6. Club size up to 8 students. Runs February 8 – March 8. Join Ms. Ellgen to learn fundamental cooking techniques and healthy recipes, including spaghetti marinara, roast chicken and vegetables, and apple pie.

Soccer Club: Cost: \$25, Wednesdays 1:30-3:15 PM for 5 weeks total on the field. Grades 4-6, co-ed. Club size minimum 8, maximum 14 students. Runs February 8 – March 8. Join Mr. Jimenez for drills to enhance soccer ability while playing fun soccer games before scrimmaging, at the end of practice.

Drawing: Cost: \$25, Thursdays 2:30-3:30PM for 5 weeks in Art Room. Grades 1-6. Class size up to 8 students. Runs February 9 – March 9. Join Ms. Snyder for creative drawing class. Students will learn the fundamentals of drawing and bring home fantastic art.

For all classes, there is a minimum registration of five (eight for soccer) students or the class will be canceled.



2017 AFTER-SCHOOL ENRICHMENT RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES: Parents are responsible for providing a snack for their children. Please let your child know that snacks must not be shared with other students for safety reasons. Parents are responsible for their child's supervision when not in class or club. Clubs end promptly, so ***please be on time picking up your child after club***. Roll will be taken in each club. Please notify Chris Errea if your child will be absent from club by leaving a message or text at 805-965-8994 ext. 1437 or emailing hardingschoolfoundation@gmail.com. Notifying the foundation or the club teacher ahead of time will save time trying to locate a missing student. If your child is to walk home, you must check and sign the bottom of the permission form.

STUDENT CONDUCT: Students must conduct themselves in a respectful, attentive, and safe manner. All students are expected to follow school rules and treat the instructor and classmates respectfully. Students who are unable to comply with these rules will be dismissed from the club without a refund.

GETTING TO AND FROM ENRICHMENT CLUBS: Students are responsible for getting to their after-school clubs, except for grades K – 2nd Grade who will be picked up by Enrichment Club Teachers (Grades 3-6 will walk to clubs on their own). All teachers will be given a list of after-school clubs their students have signed up for in order to assist with transition, but teachers will not be responsible for escorting children to their club.

A-OK students must check into A-OK each day and will be released to the Foundation Enrichment Club. Students will be released back to A-OK after Enrichment Club ends.

REFUNDS: There are no refunds or make-ups for missed classes.
