



For more than a decade *Friends of Father Judge High School, Inc.* has separately raised and invested more than \$10 million to fund campus improvements, staffing solutions, and educational programs. "The Friends" was established to ensure that 100% of all donations made to the school, stay at the school. Through this 501(c)(3) incorporated non-profit, "The Friends" work with alumni, corporations, city, state, and federal agencies to provide substantial dollars for the sustainability of the school. In the past, as a separate, corporate entity we were able to partner with city departments on our biggest projects, the building of the Mitchell Center and the improvements to Ramp Playground. The corporation, chaired by Bill St. Clair '75, and governed by a Board of Directors, operates with a corporate structure, and conforms to the strict guidelines mandated by non-profit law, to ensure that dollars are recorded, re-invested, and managed according to the mission. The sole mission of "The Friends" is to benefit Father Judge High School. As we begin the new fiscal year, "The Friends" will initiate all appeals and manage the combined fundraising of the Alumni Association and Office of Advancement.
