Grandparents and Special Friends Tea Friday, November 18th, 2016

Below is some important information about the Grandparents and Special Friends Tea. If you have any additional questions, please contact the Development Office.

- If guests will be checking students out, **the school needs prior written consent to be able to release them.** Please email Jean Dang at dang@sasr.org with their name and the student's names that they will be checking out. Even if they are on your emergency contact form, we still need permission for this specific event. Without this

prior authorization, guests will not be allowed to check out students.

- **All Grandparents were assigned a time on their invitation.** Please have them arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before their time. This should mitigate traffic and parking problems.
- The entire event will take place in the St. Anthony Parish Hall. Students will meet their grandparents/special friends at the hall.
- **All RSVP's must be in by 11/14. This is important as we will be bringing students over to the hall at designated times.**
- If students will be at school for lunch, they must bring a sack lunch and a drink. There will be no lunch provided.
- If your student doesn't have anyone coming, their grandparents are welcome to send a letter to their grandchild c/o the Development Office. We will deliver the message that morning.

Volunteers Needed



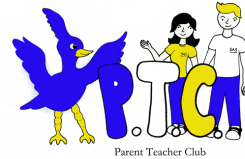
