Dear GHS Parents and Guardians,

We are pleased to announce that it is time to schedule student-parent-teacher conferences to be held March 15th (2:30p.m. – 8p.m.) and 16th (8a.m. – 2p.m.). These conferences are very important to your child's learning and to give parents the opportunity to meet with teachers. Almost two months into the new semester, students are ready to review their strengths and identify areas of improvement. In addition, teachers are ready to provide an update on your child's progress and grades to date.

As you may know from previous years, conferences last 12 minutes.

How does the scheduling process work?

As you might remember from the fall, Gorham High School has moved to an online scheduling system for parent-teacher conferences.

Once you are on the Gorham High School scheduling page, you will sign up for a time slot with each of your child's teachers. ***Please only sign up for one spot per teacher.*** (If you feel you need more time, please contact the teacher directly.) Teachers are listed in alphabetical order. Once a spot has been taken, it will appear greyed out to future viewers. You will receive a confirmation email showing all scheduled conference times. **Online scheduling will close on March 13th at 12p.m., so please sign up for a conference before then.** After 12p.m. on the 13th, you will need to contact your student's teacher directly to schedule a time to meet.

GHS Literacy Specialist, Luci Bowers, and Numeracy Specialist/STEM teacher, Terry Bartick, will also be available for conferences to discuss literacy and numeracy support for your high school student. This includes reading and math testing, organizational skills, test-taking strategies, and content area strategies.

Three of our school counselors (Ms. Worthley—grade 12, Ms. Anastasoff—grade 11, Ms. Stevens—grade 10) are available to meet during the conference times by emailing or calling 222-1102. Ms. Cherry, our grade 9 counselor, and the one responsible for 8th grade student transition, will not be available during conferences (she will be at Gorham Middle School), but you may email her for an appointment as needed.

If your student participates in a CTE (vocational) program, here is information on their spring conferences: WRVC will offer conferences on April 3rd and 5th. Please call (207) 854-0820 to schedule a conference with them. PATHS is not offering spring conferences but tells us they are communicating with their Gorham students via email.

Thank you for scheduling conferences. Communication between parents and teachers about student progress has a positive effect on student learning. We look forward to seeing you on March 15th and 16th.
