DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT

- 2002-03 Study Budget

Dr. Costello reviewed the 2001-02 budget, 2001-02 Third Interim Report, 2002-03 study budget, and a list of proposed budget reductions totaling \$12,796,975. Several members of the budget committee were present to address the process the committee followed.

In order to balance the District budget and report to the county and state that the District can meet its financial obligations, cuts are necessary. The state requires school districts to have a 2 percent unrestricted reserve. The District currently has a 0.69 percent reserve.

After Board discussion and clarification on questions and concerns, it was suggested that another special meeting be scheduled for Friday, June 7, at 2:30 p.m.

ADJOURNMENT: It was moved by Gary E. Baugh and seconded by John Bailey that, there being no further items to come before the Board of Education, the meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
