### Policy

#### **F105: INDEPENDENT EDUCATIONAL EVALUATION POLICY - SPECIAL EDUCATION**

The Milton Town School District recognizes that the Individuals with Disabilities Act (the "Act") provides a right to parents to obtain an independent evaluation of their child under the terms of the Act and regulations promulgated there-under. The School District also recognizes that, under the Act, the parent has a right to obtain such independent evaluation at public expense if the parent disagrees with an evaluation obtained or performed by the School District, unless the School District challenges the parent(s)' request at due process by showing that the School District's evaluation was appropriate, and/or that the parent's evaluation did not meet the criteria provided for by statute and regulation and by this policy and implementing procedures.

The Superintendent and his/her designee shall develop and revise procedures as needed to implement this policy and to comply with current and future State and Federal law.
