Proposed Language to be Incorporated into the Collective Bargaining Agreement

Transfer

15.2.3.3/15.3.4.2 Remove from contract

15.3.5.4 In the event of an emergency condition, employees transferred during the school year will have a minimum of two days of released time to prepare for the change. Employees transferred during the school year under emergency conditions will receive this released time as soon as the emergency condition is alleviated.

15.3.5.5 Bargaining Unit Members involuntarily transferred to a different worksite location shall have the option of utilizing 3 substitute release days or shall be compensated at their daily rate for 2 days beyond the contractual work days.


15.5 Displaced Bargaining Unit Members resulting from Modernization, Bond Construction, or Health/Safety

15.5.1 Bargaining Unit Members who are displaced as the result of Modernization, Bond Construction, or Health/Safety will be provided 2 days to pack and 2 days to unpack at the hourly instructional rate beyond a contracted day not to exceed 7 hours per day. The District will provide a substitute at no cost to the Bargaining Unit Member who elects to utilize a substitute as release time during the contractual school year.

15.5.2 The District shall provide employees who have been displaced with assistance in moving the employee's materials.

This Language will take effect upon acceptance by the Walnut Valley Unified School District (WVUSD) and the Walnut Valley Educators' Association (WVEA) on this day, March 6th, 2013 as a Memorandum of Understanding and will be entered into the collective bargaining agreement upon ratification by WVEA bargaining unit members at the next bargaining unit election.


