1. Complete application online or print
2. Payment on line or by mail. Please print or make a copy of payment receipt for your record.
3. Once payment has been received application will be forwarded to all the colleges.
4. Forward and send an official transcript to colleges and fax a copy to 404-745-0124
5. Student essays must be sent to all colleges that require them.
6. Two letters of recommendations must be sent to all colleges that you are interested in attending.

EDU Require College Essays (send essay to the college) along with two letters of recommendation.

T = transcript S= Test scores – send them to the college and enclose them with application.
