## ***STATEWIDE JUNIOR ACT DAY***

The goal of Reeds Spring High School is for all students to be successful in their postsecondary endeavors. The ACT is a college entrance exam, but can also have an impact on dual credit course acceptance, college admissions, and scholarship opportunities. For the past 2 years, all juniors have been required to take the ACT during the school day at the expense of the state. However, this year Missouri has opted out of paying for the test. ## ***PRACTICE ACT***

**October 25th from 8:00-11:20AM**

All students will have the opportunity to take a FREE practice ACT test during the school day. This will not be an official ACT test and will not be accepted by colleges. The purpose of the practice test is to help students feel more comfortable with taking the official ACT in the future. Students will also be able to identify their strengths and weaknesses, resulting in more effective study opportunities. Naviance will be much more effectively utilized once students are aware of their sample score.

### ***COLLEGE VISIT DAY***

Seniors will have the opportunity to use October 25th as a college visit day. Any student who wishes to do so will need to pick up a form in the counseling office and fill it out prior to their college visit. By doing so, the college day will count as a field trip and will not affect their attendance. By taking advantage of this opportunity, students will not be missing out on any classwork. Any senior who wishes to take the practice ACT instead of a college visit will be able to do so.
