Advisory Committee Meeting

- I. Welcome and introductions were made by Principal Jaime Mancilla, Assistant Principal Taylor Holloway, and ELD Teacher Laurie Gatz.
- II. DELAC report was shared by Kay Morikawa. ELPAC testing was discussed. Results will be sent home in July via mail/email. EL summer school is by invitation only for beginning speaking students. Information will be sent home shortly.
- III. ELAC Needs Assessment results were discussed. Administration invited parents to complete the survey. It will remain on the website for a longer period of time. Results will be used to drive next year's SPSA goals and Supplemental Grant expenditures.
- IV. ELPAC update was provided. ELPAC testing is complete. The students reported that it was easier than they thought it would be. CAASPP testing schedule was reviewed.
- V. Supplemental Grant money was discussed. The group agreed to the purchase of a Chromebook Cart for the library renovation and to implement ELD homework club next year.
- VI. Online scheduling was discussed. The window is open. ELD language arts class (depending on the numbers) will most likely be split into two classes. Students in Emerging ELD will take ELD Support class as their elective. The rest of the students will have the choice of an elective wheel.
- VII. PBIS and a new program WEB (Where Everyone Belongs) were explained in detail. The application for WEB leaders was shared and parents were encouraged to have their 7th grade students apply to be WEB leaders.
- VIII. Public Comment/Questions: Administration thanked Erika Maeda for her service and wishes her the best of luck in the future. Admin has also attended ELAC meetings at Soleado and Vista Grande as part of the transition to middle school.
