

All students will be issued the necessary instructional materials for their course work free of charge. In an effort to reduce educational costs and to promote individual responsibility for public property, the Edgecombe County Board of Education (the “Board”) establishes the following requirements for this service.

1. Records will be kept on the condition of all instructional materials, including the condition of the materials at the time they are issued to students.
2. Instructional personnel shall emphasize to students their responsibility to maintain materials in good condition.
3. Students who lose or fail to return issued instructional materials will be charged the cost of the book before a replacement will be issued.
4. Students who return materials in such condition as to make it unusable for another student will be charged for replacing it.
5. Parents or guardians will be notified of the student’s responsibility in caring for instructional materials properly and of the parents’ or guardians’ responsibility for paying for any materials that are lost or appreciably damaged.
