Creating an Original Book Jacket

1. Front cover - the name of the novel
- the author's name
- an original design (picture, graphic, or drawing)
2. Inside front flap - a summary of the novel that is engaging and concise
3. Back cover - a quotation from the novel that epitomizes the entire story
- an original design (picture, graphic, or drawing)
4. Inside back flap - a biography of the author

Each component of the book jacket must be original, neat, and attractive.
