PROPOSITION NO. ONE

RESOLVED: That the Board of Education of the Le Roy Central School District in the Counties of Genesee and Livingston be authorized to expend the sum of \$24,520,718.00 for the 2017-18 school year and to accumulate no planned balance and levy the necessary tax therefor.

PROPOSITION NO. TWO

RESOLVED: That the Trustees of the Woodward Memorial Library in the Counties of Genesee and Livingston be authorized to expend the sum of \$315,700.00 to support the Woodward Memorial Library for the 2017-18 school year.

Other business before the voters was the Annual Election of candidates for two positions as members of the Board of Education.
