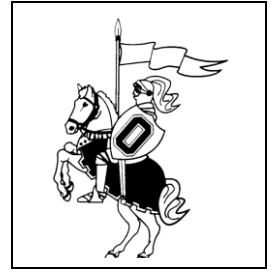

- ❖ Anyone who is not an Otsego High School student must be under 21 years of age and must fill out this form. Guest must provide proof of age with a driver's license if requested.
- ❖ No guest will be admitted the night of the dance without this form being on file.
- ❖ All guests must follow the Otsego High School Code of Conduct.
- ❖ If there are any problems, both the Otsego student and guest will be removed from the dance and parents will be notified.
- ❖ Principal's signature is needed if guest attends another high school.
- ❖ No junior high students will be allowed to attend any high school sponsored dance.
- ❖ Only one guest is allowed.
- ❖ Once you have left the premises, you are not permitted to return.
- ❖ The Otsego school administration reserves the right to remove any student and/or guest from the dance/activity or from school property.
- ❖ The administration reserves the right to deny entrances to any student and/or guest.
- ❖ I understand that attendance to a dance/activity at Otsego High School is a privilege and not a right.
- ❖ I understand that law enforcement officials and/or school officials will enforce these rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.
- ❖ THERE IS NO SMOKING AT THE DANCE, DURING THE DANCE, OR ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.
- ❖ Any student or guest shall not possess, use, transmit, sell or be under the influence of any drug or alcoholic beverage of any kind either before the dance, during the dance, or on school property.
