

Criteria for Student Entry at Mott Adult High School

Alternative Education:

- Student must be at least 16 years old by September 1st of the year they enter MAHS.
- All students must bring with them transcripts, shot records, proof of age (birth certificate or driver's license) and social security card.
- All students must take the TABE indicator test and then a survey test (Test of Adult Basic Education). The test takes 65 minutes and assesses reading and math. Students will be placed in classes based on their performance on this test.
- Students must read at a minimum of 3rd grade level as measured by the TABE or have a current valid IEP to enroll. Those reading below 5th grade level will be placed in special low level classes.
- Students 16 - 17 years old at Zimmerman and 16 - 19 years old at Broome must take our "Assessment and Referral Form" to their previous high school to be filled out by counselor, principal, or assistant principal. While there, the student should pick up transcripts and shot records.
- Students with no high school credits may be put on academic probation and have their classes limited until they display a desire to earn an education.
- Previous students with marginal academic records will be put on academic probation and have classes limited.
- Students who have signed up but not attended regularly for three consecutive semesters will have to successfully attend another school for 1 semester before re-enrolling at MAHS.
- MAHS students must be 18 years old to take night classes.
- In-school youths must be at least 16 years old (11th grade) and have a counselor's referral to take night classes. Classes are \$100 for Flint students and \$150 for non-residents. They are limited to 2 night classes.

Adult Education:

- Adults, by state definition, are 20+ years old by December 1st of the year they enter Mott Adult High School.
- All students must bring with them transcripts, shot records, proof of age (birth certificate or driver's license) and social security card.
- All students must take the TABE locator and survey test (Test of Addult Basic Education). This test assesses reading and math.
- Students will be placed in classes based on their performance on this test.
- Students must read at a minimum of 3rd grade level.
- Adult Basic Education students must take the TABE test after every 90 hours of instruction.
- Adult students must make satisfactory progress as measured by the TABE, or they will not be allowed to re-enroll.(per the state)
- Previous students with marginal academic records will be put on academic probation and have classes limited.
- Students who have signed up but not attended regularly for three semesters must successfully attend classes at another school for 1 semester before re-enrolling at MAHS.
- Adults must have at least 10 high school credits to enroll for their high school diploma. If they have less credits they should work towards earning their GED. We can not guarantee free completion of a high school diploma because of the current funding restrictions.

It is possible for all students to earn up to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ credits per semester if students attend and satisfactorily finish course work for all classes.
