**Grades K – 8** Monday – Friday 7:45 A.M. – 2:20 P.M.

An After School Club is available to students in Pre-K4 through grade eight. The program begins directly after dismissal at 2:20 P.M. and continues until 5:30 P.M. Students remain in a safe environment for recreational time, homework supervision, and arts and crafts projects. There is an additional charge for this program.

In addition to tuition, each St. Catherine of Siena family is assessed the amount of \$450 for the school year, \$225 for preschool families. This amount can be paid off through participation in various Home and School Association fundraisers.
