**AP Courses:** Wimberley High School students consistently score well above the State & National average on AP Exams. Courses offered are Biology, Calculus AB, Chemistry, Computer Science, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Physics B1, Physics B2, U.S. History, & U.S. Government. Wimberley High School offers 22 Pre-Advanced Placement courses.

**Dual-Credit Courses:** Austin Community College Courses offered are English Composition I & II, British Literature I & II, U.S. History I & II, U.S. Government, Economics, Introduction to Criminal Justice, Fundamentals of Criminal Law, Introduction to Psychology, Introduction to Sociology, Spanish I & II, College Mathematics, College Algebra, & College Physics.

**ACT/SAT Scores:** Wimberley High School students consistently score well above the State & National average. Average ACT score is 23.5 & average SAT score is 1602.

**GPA/Class Rank:** Calculated on a weighted 4.0 scale with extra points given to PAP, AP & Dual-Credit courses.
