This letter is to inform all Kahuku High and Intermediate School staff members, parents/guardians, students and community members that surveillance cameras are in use on our campus. The intent of the video surveillance cameras is to deter outsiders from entering our campus for inappropriate purposes, deter students from inappropriate behavior, induce students whose inappropriate behavior is captured on tape to admit to the incident and provide hard evidence for parents. For Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) purposes, surveillance videotapes or other media with information about a specific student are considered education records if they are kept and maintained by the school system and are subject to DOE education record requirements. Video recordings will be erased or recorded over within ten (10) calendar days of the recording unless an incident is recorded that involves the violation of law or of Chapter 8-19, Hawaii Administrative Rules ("Student Misconduct, Discipline, School Searches and Seizures, Reporting Offenses, Police Interviews and Arrests, and Restitution for Vandalism and Negligence").
